4. Strategic Infrastructure Fund Project Update High Density Library Expansion

Boris Dragicevic, Associate Vice President (Facilities Development), presented this item.

Highlights:

- The presenter reported on the plans for the expansion of the University's High Density Library, which is a project being funded under the federal Strategic Infrastructure Fund (SIF) program including:

Mackimmie complex renovation is ready to start through the approval process when selected by the Canada Green Building Council (CaGBC) to design one of its buildings as part of its CaGBC Zero Carbon Buildings Initiative. The Mackimmie building will be evaluated using five key components from the CaGBC Zero Carbon Buildings Initiative. CaGBC's initiative will lead to better design standards and championing green building.

The presenter confirmed that, if there is a seed grant program in the future, the building will apply for funding.

During the Tower renovation, several IT offices will be moved to the Smart building.
